#### ◆ Education

Hornblower's hard work, quick thinking, and tough decisions mold him into a young officer in the British navy. During the class students spend considerable time discussing Hornblower's actions, the mistakes he makes and their consequences, as well as his best decisions.

### Shakespeare for Young Scholars:

#### *The Tragedy of MacBeth*

By William Shakespeare

Ages 12-14  
Winter 2012

**Course Description:** Students study the life and times of William Shakespeare, with special attention given to the crafting of Shakespeare's verse and the language of his day. After understanding Shakespeare's background and the play's origins, students read the play in parts, discussing Shakespeare's use of biblical and classical allusions, including other literary elements. Students conclude their Shakespearean study with a formal written essay.
